NARRATIVE:

This morning Burlington Police assisted the United States Marshal Service with the execution of a search warrant on South Willard Street, in connection with an ongoing investigation. During the warrant a New York man jumped from a second story window. As he did so his pants became caught on a piece of the building and he was stuck, suspended by his pants outside of the apartment window. He was assisted down by members of the Burlington Fire Department.

The man was later identified as 25 year old man from Brooklyn, NY. The man was transported to the hospital and treated for minor injuries. It is unclear at this time what prompted him to jump from the window. At this time he has not been charged with any crime and was released.

During the execution of the warrant Alonzo Jones, a 32 year old resident of Brooklyn, NY was witnessed throwing crack cocaine out a window of the apartment. Jones was taken into custody and will appear in court later today.

Detectives from the Burlington Police Department have taken over the drug investigation related to this incident.
