### **NARRATIVE:**

The Burlington Police were called to the Burlington Bike Path in the area of College Street on April 19, 2014 at approximately 6:36 PM to investigate a suspicious circumstance. The female complainant reported that she was running with her dog on the bike path when an unknown male on a "road style" bike got behind her and appeared to be recording her lower body from approximately a foot away as she ran.

The female swatted at the male's hand, and asked what he was doing, and the male said he was looking at his phone. The male then rode away quickly. The female reported the male never touched her but made her feel very uncomfortable. The Burlington Police checked the surrounding area but did not locate the male.

The male is described as being in his mid-twenties, average height, slim build, brown hair and having a scruffy beard. The female stated that he was wearing a green hat, gray sweater and blue jeans. There are no criminal charges at this time, but the Burlington Police would like to locate the male to question him about his behavior during this incident.

The Burlington Police would like to remind the general public to be aware of your surroundings at all times and to report any suspicious behavior to the police. At this time
