NARRATIVE:

On the above date and time, Burlington Police were called to the area of North Avenue by institute Road. Multiple callers advised the police that a motor vehicle crash had occurred on North Avenue between a single motor vehicle and a truck towing a trailer with a boat attached.

On scene, police discovered a vehicle in the middle of North Avenue, which was badly damaged, along with a boat trailer which had come loose from the truck which was towing it. Further down the road was a boat, partially blocking both the northbound and southbound lanes of travel. Ultimately it was found that the car struck the boat trailer, causing the boat to break loose from the trailer.

Police quickly determined that there were no injuries at the scene, and are continuing to investigate the cause of the crash. At this time, drugs, alcohol, nor the use of electronic devices appear to play a role in the crash.

Both lanes of traffic on North Avenue were closed for a period of time to accommodate scene safety, and removal of all vehicles involved in the crash.
