## NARRATIVE:

On the above date and time, Burlington Police responded to the above address on behalf of the Milton Police Department in an attempt to locate a resident at the address, Martin Bombard. Bombard was being sought for violating his conditions of release stemming from several charges, which include an underlying charge of First Degree Aggravated Domestic Assault.

Upon making contact with Mr. Bombard he was non-compliant and would not come outside and threatened Officer's and claimed to have a gun. One officer observed Bombard to be holding what appeared to be a sword while inside of the residence. Officer's immediately established a perimeter around the residence and blocked traffic, so neighborhood residents and officers were safe. While the perimeter was established Bombard came out of the residence and was yelling for Officer's to shoot him and he then retreated back into the residence. Officer's on scene showed great restraint and remained calm while negotiations with Bombard were being established.

Just prior to a Negotiator commencing contact with Bombard he came out of the house voluntarily and surrendered to police without further incident and was taken into custody. Milton PD Officer's responded to Burlington and took custody of Bombard on their outstanding charge.
