

- The Burlington Police Department will review all applications prior to acceptance into the class.
- Academy participants are asked to miss no more than one class.
- No torn or ripped up clothing. No garments with vulgarity, profanity, or sexual innuendo.
- Photos may be taken by BPD personnel and used on the department's website and/or social media. Each participant will be required to complete a Release of Information authorization on the first day of the academy.
- Academy participants are asked to be courteous to academy instructors and fellow attendees.
- Any violent or disruptive behavior will result in expulsion from the class and a possible ban from participation in future academies.
- Participating in a Ride-Along is a requirement of the Community Academy. Each participant will be required to complete a Ride-Along application on the first day of the academy. This will allow attendees to participate in a Ride-Along at their convenience during or after the academy ends.
- A criminal records check will be conducted on all applicants.
