Winter Parking Ban Tonight (1/19/19) and Tomorrow Night (1/20/19) Call 802-658-SNOW for Updates

Burlington, VT – A winter PARKING BAN will go into effect tonight at 10pm to help city crews maintain the safest possible road conditions and clear the roads of snow and ice. The ban will be in effect from 10PM tonight - 7AM Sunday (1/20) and again from 10PM Sunday (1/20) until 7AM Monday (1/21) - throughout Burlington, except in the downtown zone where parking bans are in effect from midnight - 6AM; see end of press release for streets within the downtown zone enforcement area. Any vehicles remaining on the street during the parking ban may be issued a \$125.00 parking ticket by Burlington Police Parking Enforcement and towed to another location. Parking bans are declared by 3pm. Call 802-658-SNOW for future updates or look for the parking ban lights around the city. Please travel safely and stay warm!

Free parking is available in city-owned garages:

- Starting at 10PM
- Normally, cars must be removed by 8AM when the ban is over to avoid paying the full daily rate; Monday is also a holiday and parking is free until 11:59PM
- The following city-owned garages offer this free parking:

Downtown Zone:

By ordinance, Zone F shall include all streets bounded by the following streets:

- The easternmost boundary shall be defined and include South Willard Street from Pearl Street to Maple Street.
- The southernmost boundary shall be defined by and include Maple Street from South Willard Street to South Winooski Avenue, South Winooski Avenue from Maple Street to Adams Street, Adams Street from South Winooski Avenue to St. Paul Street, St. Paul Street from Adams Street to Kilburn Street, and Kilburn Street.
- The westernmost boundary shall be defined by Lake Champlain.
- The northernmost boundary shall be defined by and include Sherman Street; North Champlain Street from Sherman Street to Peru Street; Peru Street; Elmwood Avenue from Peru Street to Grant Street; Grant Street; North Union Street from Grant Street to Pearl Street; and Pearl Street from South Union Street to South Willard Street.
