8-9 Ballot Questions

Mayor Weinberger and other city officials will brief the NPA about the "City Ballot Items" on the November ballot:

- 1) The authorization "**to issue general obligation bonds or notes not to exceed \$9M** for the purpose of funding one or more reserve funds to be used for working capital, costs and expenses for the City and its departments, excluding BT, thereby reducing the City's reliance on short-term debt".
- 2) The authorization "**to issue general obligation bonds or notes in one or more series pursuant to the Urban Renewal Plan for the Waterfront Revitalization District in an amount not to exceed \$6,050,000**"
- 3) Increase the City tax rate by one-half-cent for the "**Bike Path Improvement and Maintenance Fund**".
- 4) Shall the people of Burlington support **the legalization, regulation and taxation of all cannabis and hemp products?**
