

AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO LICENSE AGREEMENT

In the year Two Thousand Nine.....
Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

That WHEREAS, LI 2VT LLC d/b/a JUNIOR'S of Burlington, Vermont (hereinafter JUNIOR'S) is an establishment doing business in a commercial building located at 176 Main Street in the City of Burlington, Vermont; and

WHEREAS, JUNIOR'S desires to place 3 tables and 6 chairs in the public right-of-way in front of its establishment at 176 Main Street; and

WHEREAS, JUNIOR'S wishes to enter into a License Agreement with the City for such tables and chairs; and

WHEREAS, the placement of the respective tables and chairs has been reviewed and approved by the Department of Public Works with conditions to address public safety concerns; and

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Burlington, Sec. 48XLIX and the Code of Ordinances Sec. 27-32 require authorization by the City Council for such use of a public thoroughfare for periods in excess of thirty (30) days;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this City Council hereby authorizes JUNIOR'S to place 3 tables and 6 chairs on a portion of the public right-of-way adjacent to its establishment at 176 Main Street. as indicated in and pursuant to its License
