CORRECTION OF AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE AND FINANCING OF NEW POLICE VEHICLES

In the year Two Thousand Nineí .. Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

That WHEREAS, the Police Department owns and operates a fleet of vehicles in support of the Department's programs and services to the residents of Burlington; and

WHEREAS, the Department and DPW Equipment Maintenance Director have developed a continuing program and schedule for the acquisition of new vehicles to maintain a reliable and cost effective fleet of vehicles; and

WHEREAS, this resolution corrects total price and trade in credit amounts in the resolution passed by the City Council on September 14, 2009, authorizing the purchase and refinancing of new police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Department recommends the purchase of four new cruisers and one Toyota Camry Hybrid for a total price of \$140,218 after a \$2,500 credit for the trade in of a 1998 Pathfinder;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Resolution supersedes and replaces the resolution adopted by the City Council on September 14, 2009, and the City Council hereby approves and authorizes the Chief of the Police Department, or his designee, to purchase the new vehicles for a total price of \$140,218 after a \$2,500 trade-in credit and further authorizes the Chief Administrative Officer to finance the acquisition through the City's master lease program.
