

SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET RESOLUTION #2010- 4  
PLANNING & ZONING FLOOD INSURANCE RATE MAP

In the year Two Thousand Nine.....

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

That WHEREAS, the Department of Planning and Zoning of the City of Burlington has been working with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) to update the Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) and Flood Insurance Study (FIS) for the lower Winooski River; and

WHEREAS, the results of this project to date have confirmed the City's initial expectations that there are significant differences in the extent and character of the flood hazard area in the Intervale since the last FIRM and FIS in 1978; and

WHEREAS, FEMA has requested the City model topographic conditions that were in existence when the initial FIRM was published in 1978 to be assured that a proposed change in the FIRM does not automatically grandfather any previously uncommitted encroachments within the special flood hazard area; and

WHEREAS, FEMA and the Vermont DEC have requested the City perform an additional study for an estimated cost of \$17,000 to complete the FEMA requested analysis for a new FIRM and FIS;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the budget for the Department of Planning and Zoning for Fiscal Year 2010 is amended as follows:

Expenditure Account Code 64990 Other Professional Services Increase by \$17,000

The increase in expenses to be funded through a projected increase in the level of Planning and Zoning fees by a corresponding amount.
