STUDENT HOUSING ON CAMPUS

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

That WHEREAS, the Burlington City Council approved the attached Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) in March, 2009, requiring The University of Vermont (UVM) to undertake "good faith" efforts to build more housing on UVM's Campus; and

WHEREAS almost a year has passed since this MOU was entered into, and these "good faith" efforts were to have begun, it is appropriate and timely for the City Council to receive a report from the UVM Administration and the City on the progress that has been made to build more housing on UVM's Campus;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council respectfully requests the Mayor and representative(s) of the Department of Planning and Zoning and representative(s) of the UVM Administration report to the City Council at the meeting of February 8, 2010, on what actions have been taken and what progress has been made to build more student housing on the UVM Campus.
