

AGREEMENT FOR POLICE SERVICES AT  
BURLINGTON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

In the year Two Thousand Ten.....

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

That WHEREAS, Burlington International Airport Department (“BIA”) is obligated to provide for a proper level of law enforcement, security and physical protection services, and traffic control at the Airport to satisfy the requirements of the Federal Government and its agencies regulating airport safety and operations and to enforce the laws of the State of Vermont, Cities of Burlington and South Burlington, and rules and regulations of the BIA; and

WHEREAS, the Burlington Police Department (“BPD”) has been effectively and efficiently providing these services under agreements since 1993; and

WHEREAS, the most current agreement between the BIA and BPD (“Departments”) has expired and is in need of being reviewed and renewed; and

WHEREAS, the Departments have reviewed their respective needs and requirements and have come to an agreement on a new Police Services Agreement for the BIA; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Finance has reviewed this agreement (attached) on February 22, 2010 and March 22, 2010 and has determined that it effectively meets the needs and obligations of each Department and the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the respective department heads of BIA, Brian Searles, and BPD, Michael Schirling, be and hereby are authorized to execute the attached Agreement for Police Services at Burlington International Airport, subject to the prior review of the City’s Chief Administrative Officer and the City’s legal counsel, as necessary.
