16 WHEREAS, the Vermont Public Service Board (PSB) has requested Vermont electric  
17 utilities to offer their street lighting customers the option of using light emitting diode (LED)  
18 technology, which is more energy efficient than other lighting technologies; and

19 WHEREAS, Burlington Electric Department (BED) has identified specific LED  
20 technology options for deployment, and has developed the monthly charges for providing LED  
21 street lighting; and

22 WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on February 10, 2010, the Burlington Board of  
23 Electric Commissioners approved revisions to BED's street lighting tariff to allow the use of  
24 LED technology; and

25 WHEREAS, at its meeting on March 8, 2010, the Burlington Board of Finance approved  
26 the revisions to BED's street lighting tariff to allow the use of LED technology;

27 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that BED's Street Lighting  
28 (SL) Rate Tariff as amended to include LED technology options is hereby approved and BED is  
29 authorized to proceed before the PSB to obtain approval of the amended tariff in the form  
30 attached hereto.
