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AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE REPLACEMENT FOR THE  
1994 SLUDGE TANKER TRUCK

In the year Two Thousand Ten.....

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

That WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works (DPW) has tanker truck equipment, a primary purpose of which is to haul sludge from the wastewater treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, DPW has a capital equipment replacement plan and this plan calls for the trade-in of DPW's 1994 International 2574 Tanker in FY11 from the Wastewater Division's approved budget; and

WHEREAS, DPW solicited bids for the replacement of the tanker and reviewed the bids internally with Wastewater and Equipment Maintenance staff; and

WHEREAS, based on the bids, DPW determined that the best overall price and value, including trade-in-value, is to purchase the 2011 International tanker from J & B International for a net price of \$149,573; and

WHEREAS, this price is consistent with and within DPW's capital replacement plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Finance reviewed this proposed purchase at its July 12, 2010 meeting and recommended approval of the tanker through the City's master vehicle lease program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council approves and authorizes DPW, through its Director or his designee to purchase the 2011 International tanker from J & B International for the net purchase price of \$149,573 through the City's master lease program.
