

AUTHORIZATION FOR EXECUTION OF  
CONTRACT WITH THE DOCK DOCTORS  
RE: REPLACEMENT OF “D” DOCK

In the year Two Thousand Ten.....

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

That WHEREAS, there is a need to replace the “D” dock at Burlington’s Waterfront which has been utilized well beyond its recommended serviceable life; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Parks and Recreation has contracted successfully with The Dock Doctors, 19 Little Otter Lane, Ferrisburgh, VT, in the past; and

WHEREAS, The Dock Doctors is the only local supplier of the galvanized steel truss dock system which the Department seeks as a replacement for “D” dock; and

WHEREAS, because using a local supplier will keep travel and delivery costs low; and

WHEREAS, because Department staff can work at The Dock Doctors’ site to install the requisite power to the dock at a material costs only; and

WHEREAS, The Dock Doctors has provided a estimate for the purchase of \$171,000.00, excluding power; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on Monday, August 2, 2010, the Board of Finance recommended and approved that the Department of Parks and Recreation be authorized to enter into a contract not to exceed \$200,000 with The Dock Doctors for purchase of a replacement dock for “D” dock;

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby authorizes the Department of Parks and Recreation to enter into a contract with The Dock Doctors in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00, for the purchase of the replacement dock for “D” dock and the Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to lease/purchase finance the same under the City’s annual lease purchase finance program for FY 2011; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mari Steinbach, Director of Parks and Recreation is hereby authorized to execute said contract subject to the prior review and approval of the City Attorney’s Office.
