

Supplemental Budget Resolution # 2011-06  
AUTHORIZATION FOR ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION  
OF 2010 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) FUNDING FOR  
CRIME PREVENTION PROGRAMS

In the year Two Thousand Ten.....

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

That WHEREAS, the City of Burlington (“City”) is eligible for 2010 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) funding from the U.S. Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, JAG funding is intended to support a broad range of crime prevention efforts and can be expended over a four-year period; and

WHEREAS, through the Mayor’s Office, the City applied for JAG funding and was informed on September 3, 2010 that it had been awarded a grant of \$112,816; and

WHEREAS, prior to applying for JAG funding, Mayor Kiss sent a memorandum dated May 19, 2010 to the Council asking for review and comment on the City’s planned JAG application and program allocations; and

WHEREAS, at the September 13, 2010 Board of Finance meeting the Board recommended that the Mayor be authorized to accept the 2010 JAG award and amend the budget to reflect this appropriation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Honorable Mayor Bob Kiss is hereby authorized to execute the 2010 JAG funding agreement and accept the grant award of \$112,816; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Community and Economic Development Office budget is amended to appropriate a federal grant as revenue to fund the crime prevention programs described in Burlington 2010 JAG application.
