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EXTENDING RESIDENTIAL OCCUPANCY LIMITS

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

That WHEREAS, in 2008, at the end of the Zoning Rewrite, the City Council passed a Resolution requesting that a joint City Council Ordinance /Planning Commission Committee address the issue of “Residential Occupancy limits for RH District” as well as other issues; and

WHEREAS, the above mentioned joint committee was not able to take up the issue of Residential Occupancy limits due to it’s focus on a larger issue and lack of time; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, at that time, was supportive of extending the Residential Occupancy limits to the RH;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council requests the Planning Commission address the issue of extending the Residential Occupancy limits to the RH and refer its recommendation back to the City Council by December 1, 2010.
