

APPOINTMENT OF ACTING WARD CLERK FOR WARD SIX

In the year Two Thousand Ten.....

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

That WHEREAS, the City of Burlington Special City Election Meeting occurred on November 2, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Linda Ayer, Ward Clerk for Ward Six, was unexpectedly absent for the Special City Election which was held on November 2, 2010 due to an emergency family health issue; and

WHEREAS, Linda Ayer, Ward Clerk for Ward Six, requested that Mary Ellen Manock, elected Ward Six Inspector of Election, be appointed to serve as Acting Ward Six Ward Clerk for the Special City Election Meeting that was held on November 2, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the City Council must fill a vacancy in any ward office, including the office of ward clerk, when the vacancy occurs due to an inability to serve, pursuant to City Charter §13, as happened in this circumstance; and

WHEREAS, this emergency arose at a time between City Council meetings, such that Mary Ellen Manock, who had agreed to serve as Acting Ward Clerk for Ward Six, did perform the duties of acting ward clerk, doing so with great competence;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Burlington City Council hereby approves the appointment of Mary Ellen Manock (D) as the Acting Ward Clerk for Ward Six for the November 2, 2010 Special City Election Meeting and ratifies her service for that election, and thanks her for her service during this emergency.
