1. AGENDA

2. MAYOR'S STATE OF THE CITY ADDRESS

Mayor Kiss gave the State of the City address (copy on file in the Clerk/Treasurer's Office).

3. OATH OF OFFICE-NEWLY-ELECTED AND RE-ELECTED COUNCILORS

At the request of CAO Leopold, Mayor Kiss administered oaths to the newly elected (Emma Mulvaney-Stanak, Bram Kranichfeld, Kurt Wright) and re-elected City Councilors (Keogh, Decelles, Paul, Berezniak, Adrian).

4. ELECTION OF CITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT

CAO Leopold opened the floor for nominations for City Council President.

Councilor Adrian nominated Councilor Keogh.

On a motion by Councilors Bushor and Decelles, the Council voted unanimously to close the floor to further nominations.

Councilor Keogh was elected City Council President.

5. ELECTION OF BOARD OF FINANCE MEMBERS

Councilor Decelles nominated Councilor Wright for a seat on the Board of Finance.

Councilor Mulvaney-Stanak nominated Councilor Bushor for a seat on the Board of Finance.

Councilor Adrian then requested a roll call. The votes were as follows:

For Councilor Wright: Adrian, Bushor, Berezniak, Kranichfeld, Caldwell, Kaplan, Wright, Keogh, Shannon, Kehoe, Paul, Decelles Dober.

For Councilor Bushor: Mulvaney-Stanak

Councilor Wright was elected by a vote of 13 to 1 to the first open seat on the Board of Finance.

For the second seat on the Board of Finance, the following nominations were made:

Councilor Mulvaney-Stanak nominated Councilor Bushor for a seat on the Board of Finance.

Councilor Shannon nominated Councilor Paul for a seat on the Board of Finance.

Councilor Kehoe nominated Councilor Kaplan for a seat on the Board of Finance.

Councilor Adrian requested a roll call.

For Councilor Bushor: Bushor, Caldwell, Mulvaney-Stanak, Wright, Dober (5)

For Councilor Kaplan: Adrian, Berezniak, Kaplan, Kehoe (4)

For Councilor Paul: Kranichfeld, Keogh, Shannon, Paul, Decelles (5)

At this time, 7:42 p.m., Councilor Adrian requested a recess. The Council reconvened at 7:48 p.m.

Councilor Kehoe nominated Councilor Kaplan for a seat on the Board of Finance.

Councilor Mulvaney-Stanak nominated Councilor Bushor for a seat on the Board of Finance.

Councilor Shannon nominated Councilor Paul for a seat on the Board of Finance.

Councilor Adrian requested a roll call.

The second round of voting was as follows:

For Councilor Bushor: Bushor, Caldwell, Mulvaney-Stanak, Dober (4)

For Councilor Kaplan: Adrian, Berezniak, Kaplan, Wright, Kehoe (5)

For Councilor Paul: Kranichfeld, Keogh, Shannon, Paul, Decelles (5)

At this time, 7:52 p.m., Councilor Adrian requested a recess. The Council reconvened at 8:06 p.m.

Councilor Shannon nominated Councilor Paul for a seat on the Board of Finance.

Councilor Wright nominated Councilor Bushor for a seat on the Board of Finance.

Councilor Adrian requested a roll call.

The third round of voting was as follows:

For Councilor Bushor: Bushor, Caldwell, Mulvaney-Stanak, Wright, Dober (5)

For Councilor Paul: Adrian, Berezniak, Kranichfeld, Kaplan, Keogh, Shannon, Kehoe, Paul, Decelles (9)

Councilor Paul was elected to the Board of Finance by a vote of 9 to 5.
