14 In the year Two Thousand Eleven.....  
15 Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

16  
17 That WHEREAS, the Public Works Department anticipates that revenues generated under the  
18 current rate schedule will not meet the over-all revenue requirements needed to provide  
19 wastewater services to the residents of the City; and

20  
21 WHEREAS, the Department, the Public Works Commission and the Board of Finance  
22 now recommends to the City Council, that the current wastewater rates be increased; and

23  
24 WHEREAS, in 2008 the City Council, with the unanimous concurrence of the Board of  
25 Finance and the Mayor’s Budget Task Force recommended the City establish wastewater rates to  
26 provide sufficient revenues to fund debt service for the refinancing of debt to the State of  
27 Vermont.

29 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the wastewater rate shall be increased as  
30 follows: from a current rate of 4.71 dollars per hundred cubic feet to a rate of 5.18 dollars per  
31 hundred cubic feet;

32  
33 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the water rate for rate payers of combined  
34 water and wastewater service shall remain at the current rate of 3.17 dollars per hundred cubic  
35 feet;

36  
37 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the water rate for rate payers of exclusively  
38 water service shall remain at the current rate of 3.23 dollars per hundred cubic feet;

39  
40 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the water and wastewater increases set forth  
41 herein shall be effective on July 1, 2011.
