15 Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

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17 That WHEREAS, the City of Burlington ("City") is eligible for 2011 Justice Assistance Grant  
18 (JAG) funding from the U.S. Department of Justice; and

19 WHEREAS, JAG funding is intended to support a broad range of crime prevention  
20 efforts and can be expended over a four-year period; and

21 WHEREAS, through the Mayor's Office, the City applied for JAG funding and was  
22 informed on August 23, 2011 that it had been awarded a grant of \$83,670; and

23 WHEREAS, on September 19, 2011, the Board of Finance recommended that the Mayor  
24 be authorized to accept the 2011 JAG award and amend the budget to reflect this appropriation;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Honorable Mayor Bob Kiss is hereby  
26 authorized to execute the 2011 JAG funding agreement and accept the grant award of \$83,670;

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Community and Economic Development Office  
29 budget is amended to appropriate a federal grant as revenue to fund the crime prevention  
30 programs described in the Burlington 2011 JAG application.
