

Parking downtown Burlington during the holidays just got a lot easier on weeknights and weekends during the holidays. 850 additional free parking spaces are available to downtown holiday shoppers from November 24th through January 7, 2007. There are more than 300 retailers located in the downtown area.

The extra 850 parking spaces available in Downtown Burlington will make shoppers smile at how easy it will be to find a place to park. Burlington's municipal parking garages and Burlington Town Center garage also offer two hours free parking and ALL of the parking meters are free during holiday weekends. Downtown Burlington offers holiday shoppers 4850 available parking spaces, which equals up to 704,240 hours of free parking time!
