NARRATIVE:

On January 30th, 2019, the Burlington Police responded to the UVM Medical Center for a report of a male who had suffered a non-life-threatening stab wound to his chest. The victim, a 36-year-old male from Colchester, was treated and released. He was uncooperative in the investigation. Detectives nevertheless were able to determine the stabbing occurred in the roadway on Marion Street in Burlington and was the result of an altercation between two males who are known to one another.

The suspect has been identified as William James Dunn, Jr. He is 35 years old with no current residence. He is described as a black male, 6'1", 180lbs with an athletic build, dreadlocked hair, and he is heavily tattooed on his arms, chest, and neck.

Our investigation suggests the stabbing was personal in nature and there is no ongoing threat to the public.
