NARRATIVE:

On 20 September 2019, The Burlington Police Department responded to the New North End for a reported larceny from a motor vehicle. The owner of the vehicle reported approximately \$1,500.00 worth of tools stolen from the bank of his/her truck.

The larceny was captured on video surveillance and showed at approximately 2355 hours, a white male approximately 5'9" to 6'0" feet tall exit a white 4 door sedan. The suspect vehicle waits in the distance as the male suspect walked over to a few vehicles parked in a residential parking lot. The male suspect tried a door handle to one vehicle and found it to be locked. The male suspect walked over to the victim's trucks using a flashlight to look into the bed of the truck. The suspect opens the bed Cab and partially climbs inside the truck removing a bag containing tools. The male suspect walked back to the suspect vehicle, waiting, and then flees the
