NARRATIVE

On the evening of Sunday February 23, 2020, members of the Burlington Police Department responded to the area of 187 Church Street in Burlington, VT for report of a male who was on scene yelling and threatening individuals. The suspect was identified as 43-year-old Nassor Debique. Mr. Debique is known by the Burlington Police Department and has an extensive history for police services.

While police were still in contact with Mr. Debique, he spat at a group of people who were not involved in the incident, but rather were passersby.

This incident was (1) one of (4) four involving Mr. Debique on February 23, 2020. Within the last (7) seven days, Mr. Debique has been involved in (18) eighteen incidents. Mr. Debique's involvements over the last (7) seven days have included civil trespassing, local ordinance violations, multiple disorderly conduct incidents and more. He has been cited (2) two times this week.
