NARRATIVE:

At approximately 1818 hours on Monday, April 13, 2020, Burlington Police Department dispatch received calls reporting a shooting at 44 North Union Street. Officers responded and found a female victim, 35, who had been shot once in the chest. She was conscious and alert and identified her assailant as Joshua L. Brissette, 35, who was known to her from a past relationship.


Just five minutes earlier, at 1813 hours, dispatch had received reports from a woman stating that her roommate, Mr. Brissette, had stolen her vehicle from a residence on North Champlain Street. Mr. Brissette allegedly drove the stolen vehicle to North Union Street. He approached the shooting victim and a male companion and opened fire on them, discharging several rounds and striking the victim.

The victim was transported to UVMMC and treated for non-fatal injuries.

Mr. Brissette fled the scene in the stolen vehicle. Detectives made contact with family members and were able to work with them to have Mr. Brissette turn himself in at Burlington Police Headquarters at approximately 2315 hours. He is currently in police custody.
