NARRATIVE:

On 8/1/2021 at about 0400 hours the Burlington Police Department received multiple 911 calls regarding potential gunshots/fireworks in the area of the Andy A_Dog Williams Skatepark. Officers responded to the area but did not locate any evidence of gunfire or complainants / witnesses, and there were no further callers.

At about 1618 hours another caller advised that there appeared to be bullet holes in the 300 Lake Street apartment building. Officers responded and were able to locate multiple bullet holes. A bullet fragment was also recovered from an apartment in the building.

Officers secured the area and searched for additional evidence with the help of the Burlington Police Department Identification Unit. Multiple shell casings were located in the parking lot of the skatepark. BPD detectives are actively investigating this case. Preliminary information indicates that parties who were in the vicinity at the time of the incident are associated with parties involved in the gunfire incident that occurred early on Saturday morning at S Winooski Avenue and Bank Street.
