NARRATIVE:

On August 19, 2021, The Burlington Police Department has received multiple calls from business owners along the 1100 block of North Avenue regarding their businesses being broken into or attempted to be broken into.

Preliminary investigation revealed forced entry was made into one (1) business resulting in property being stolen, to include portions of Vermont State Inspection stickers. Several other businesses in the Hannaford Plaza reported pry marks on doors however the suspect (s) was unsuccessful with gaining entry into the businesses.

In addition to these incidents mentioned above, Burlington Police Department received 4 more reports of burglaries, one was a residence, where the homeowner was leaving for work and interrupted a male attempting to climb through a window. The male suspect fled the scene. However, the homeowner did not report this incident to the police until a few hours later.

The remaining burglaries and attempted burglaries occurred in the area of 400 Pine St, all businesses. Preliminary investigation revealed the suspect(s) gained entry into one (1) business

and stole property. The other businesses suffered pry marks on doors however the suspect(s) was unsuccessful with gaining entry into the businesses.

A total of 11 burglaries occurred overnight in the City of Burlington.
