## NARRATIVE:

On 8/31/21 it was reported to South Burlington Police that Marlon Taylor Jr. allegedly stole cash from a Garda money truck parked outside the University Mall in South Burlington.

On 9/3/21 shortly after 4:00 PM Burlington Police located Marlon Taylor Jr. in downtown Burlington. Taylor Jr. was taken into custody without incident pursuant to an active arrest warrant for the felony charge of Grand Larceny. Taylor Jr. was transported to the Northwest Correctional Facility where he was lodged for lack of bail which was set at \$40,000 by the court. Taylor Jr. is scheduled to appear in court on the morning of 9/7/21.

## § 2501. Grand larceny

A person who steals from the actual or constructive possession of another, other than from his or her person, money, goods, chattels, bank notes, bonds, promissory notes, bills of exchange or other bills, orders, or certificates, or a book of accounts for or concerning money, or goods due or to become due or to be delivered, or a deed or writing containing a conveyance of land, or any other valuable contract in force, or a receipt, release or defeasance, writ, process, or public record, shall be imprisoned not more than 10 years or fined not more than \$5,000.00, or both, if the money or other property stolen exceeds \$900.00 in value.
