Arrested for suspicion of Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Child Endangerment

NARRATIVE:

On January 4, 2022 at approximately 1521 hours, Burlington Police Department received a 911 call reporting that a vehicle being operated by a female had nearly hit multiple cars and struck a curb at the Miller Center located on Gosse Court. There was also information that the female picked up a child at the Miller Center.

Officers located the vehicle being driven on Ethan Allen Parkway, observed it being driven in an erratic manner, and conducted a traffic stop. The operator, Jacquelyn Perron, 36, performed roadside standardized field sobriety tests. She was then taken into custody for suspicion of driving under the influence of alcohol. A three-year-old child who was present in the vehicle was released to a relative at the scene. Ms. Perron was processed at the police department and registered a BAC of 0.344. State law defines operating a vehicle under the influence of alcohol as having a BAC of 0.08.

Ms. Perron was released on a citation to appear in Chittenden County Superior Court on January 25, 2022, at 0815 hours to answer charges of DUI and Child Endangerment.
