SUSPECT DISPOSITION:		
Steven Leclair was arrested and charged with Burglary. Mr. Leclair was lodged on \$1500.00 bail at Northwest Correctional Facility and scheduled to appear in court on 02/10/22 at 1000 hours.		

NARRATIVE:

On 09 February 2022, at approximately 2136 hours, Officers of the Burlington Police Department responded to the area of Mill St, in the City of Burlington for a report of someone actively breaking into the businesses. The caller advised they observed on their security cameras a person inside the business.

Officers arrived on scene, set up a perimeter, and entered the building to search for the person seen on security cameras. Officers located a male exiting one of the offices on the second floor and detained the male. The male was identified as Steven Leclair, age 38. Leclair is known to Law Enforcement from previous law enforcement encounters. Leclair was found in possession of several items to include electronics. These items were recovered and returned to the owner.

Leclair was taken into custody and transported to the Burlington Police Department. Leclair was lodged on \$1500.00 bail and transported to Northwest Correctional Facility. Leclair was scheduled to appear in court on 10 February 2022 at 1000 hours.

Leclair's criminal history revealed 1 failure to appear for court proceedings, 9 Felony charges (6 convictions), 13 misdemeanor charges (9 convictions), 1 Escape charge (1 conviction), and 1 Violation of probation charge (1 conviction). Leclair has 4 convictions for Burglary and 1 conviction for stolen property.
