NARRATIVE:

At approximately 1006 hours on Tuesday, March 1, 2022, Burlington Police Department dispatchers received calls reporting a bank robbery at the People's United Bank on North Avenue. The suspect allegedly threatened the use of a weapon, took money, and fled the scene.

Officers responded and began an investigation and canvass. With five patrol officers on duty, BPD supervisors requested and received assistance from law-enforcement partners from Colchester, the University of Vermont, and South Burlington. This included a canine track by a South Burlington K9 officer. At approximately 1016 hours the Miller Center was notified and advised to lock down, which is standard operating procedure for facilities like schools and childcare when a felon is being sought in the vicinity. Because the Miller Center was also functioning as a Town Meeting Day polling place, however, that lockdown was reversed by Chief Murad at 1045

The suspect in this crime is currently unapprehended. Detectives are actively pursuing leads and request that anyone with information about this incident contact the Burlington Police Department at (802) 658-2704.
