Investigation is still pending and this is preliminary information being released and is subject to change pending new information or leads.

This is currently an ongoing investigation. This is the eight (8th) gunfire incident in 2022.

NARRATIVE:

On May 15, 2022 at approximately 0400 hrs, Burlington Police received a 911 call regarding a shooting that occurred in the area of the 200 block of No. Willard St. The caller reported hearing what sounded like a gunshot followed by a male running after two males.

Officers responded and recovered ballistics evidence consistent with a firearm discharged. Officers approached the apartment in question to check for individuals who may have been injured by gunfire, finding the apartment empty. Officers discovered a firearm on the ground next to the residence in question. Preliminary investigation revealed multiple shots were fired. As Officers gathered evidence on the scene, University of Vermont Medical Center's Emergency Department notified the Burlington Police Department that a male walked into the Emergency Department with gunshot wounds. Officers were dispatched to the University of Vermont Medical Center's Emergency Department to collect evidence and speak with the male who had suffered gunshot wounds. Officers confirmed this male was involved with the gunfire incident and are gathering information to see the extent of the male's involvement.

Burlington Police Detectives and Officers have secured the scene and seized the apartment, pending a search warrant. At this time, preliminary evidence indicates this is an isolated incident and that the public is not in danger.
