Anthony Adalio was taken into custody for Aggravated Operating without Owner's Consent, Operating without Owner's Consent, 2 counts of Possession of Stolen Property, 1 count of Possession of Heroin and Cocaine

Investigation is still pending and this is preliminary information being released and is subject to change pending new information or leads.

NARRATIVE:

On May 25, 2022, at approximately 1000 hours, Burlington Police Department received a call of a stolen vehicle complaint. The caller stated the male who stole the vehicle impersonated an employee of Uhaul and drove off in the vehicle.

Burlington Police Officers spotted the stolen Uhaul vehicle later in the afternoon on St. Paul St near Pine St being operated by a male. Burlington Police observed the stolen vehicle had stopped on Main St in front of the Flynn Theater. The male operator exited the vehicle and was taken into custody.

The male was identified as Anthony Adalio, age 32. Adalio was charged with Operating without Owner's Consent, Possession of Stolen Property, and Possession of Heroin and Cocaine for this investigation. Adalio was also charged with Aggravated Operating without Owner's Consent, as he was a person of interest in a burglary that occurred on April 16, 2022 in which car keys and vehicle were stolen. In addition, Adalio was charged for Possession of Stolen Property relating to a criminal investigating where a vehicle was stolen on May 23, 2022 from Handy's Service Station located Downtown, Burlington. Adalio provided information to the whereabouts of the vehicle, which was later recovered.

Information is preliminary and subject to change.



Adalio was lodged at Northwest Correctional Facility and ordered held by the Honorable Judge on \$10,000 bail.
