Lance Bartlett was taken into custody for Aggravated Operating without Owners Consent, Possession of Stolen Property, Driving while License Criminally Suspended, and Possession of Heroin/Fentanyl, Bartlett was lodged at		

Property, Driving while License Criminally Suspended, and Possession of Heroin/Fentanyl. Bartlett was lodged at Northwest Correctional Facility on \$5000 bail.

Investigation is still pending and this is preliminary information being released and is subject to change pending new information or leads.

NARRATIVE:

On May 25, 2022, at approximately 0653 hours, Burlington Police Department responded to a business in Colchester for a recovered stolen vehicle. Colchester Police Department responded to the parking lot of the business for a report of a parked vehicle being occupied by a male sitting in the driver's seat who seem to be in need of medical attention.

The male operator was identified as Lance Bartlett, age 40. Preliminary investigation revealed the vehicle Bartlett was in possession of was reported stolen out of Burlington, VT on May 12, 2022. Bartlett was taken into custody for Aggravated Operating without Owners Consent, Possession of Stolen Property, Driving while License Criminally Suspended, and Possession of Heroin/Fentanyl. Bartlett was transported to Chittenden County Superior Courthouse where the Honorable Judge ordered Bartlett to be held on \$5,000 bail. Bartlett is a person of interest and has been arrested in multiple stolen vehicle and possession of stolen property investigations.

Bartlett's criminal history reveals 6 Violations of Court Orders or Conditions (4 convictions), 9 felony charges (4 convictions), 44 Misdemeanor charges (23 convictions), 3 Assaultive charges (3 convictions), and 8 violation of Probation/Parole charges (4 convictions).
