NARRATIVE:

On Saturday, June 18th, 2022, at approximately 12:44 AM, Burlington Police Department dispatchers received multiple 911 calls for sounds of gunshots and screaming in the vicinity of the Marketplace Parking Garage in downtown Burlington. The involved parties fled the scene prior to the arrival of responding officers.

The preliminary investigation indicated that a disturbance between two groups of people led to a gunfight between two individuals. Officers and detectives recovered additional ballistics evidence and canvassed extensively. This investigation is ongoing and in the earliest stages, however, there was no indication that anyone was struck by the gunfire.

This is the 13th gunfire incident of 2022. The BPD defines a gunfire incident as an incident for which police have probable cause that a firearm was discharged and reasonable suspicion that it was discharged in a criminal manner.
