Investigation is still pending and this is preliminary information being released and is subject to change pending new information or leads.

NARRATIVE:

On 16 August 2022, at approximately 1833 hours, the Burlington Dispatch Center received 911 calls regarding a motor vehicle collision verse a bicyclist on North Avenue and Loaldo Dr.

Officers arrived on scene to find a 20 year old female lying in the roadway being attended to by Burlington Fire Department. Officers spoke to several witnesses and gathered statements. Preliminary investigation revealed that the vehicle was traveling southbound and the bicyclist was traveling southbound in the marked bike lane. Witnesses stated the bicyclist suddenly veered into the path of the vehicle who slammed on the brakes to avoid hitting the bicyclist.

The bicyclist received non-life injuries and was transported by Burlington Fire Department to University of Vermont Medical Center's Emergency Department for medical treatment. Speed or alcohol are not a factor at this time.
