2. Some of the insurance requirements in the standard contract see excessive for a nonconstruction project. Would the City consider reduced and/or waived professional liability, umbrella liability, and/or value papers?

Specific insurance requirements will be negotiated with a successful firm based on the proposed scope of work. Generally, the City may consider waiving Umbrella liability if the scope of work includes exclusively virtual work and in exchange for a higher general liability coverage; may reduce Professional liability for the scope covered to \$1M per occurrence and \$2M in aggregate; and may reduce coverage for valuable papers to \$25,000.
