NARRATIVE:

On November 25th, 2022, dispatchers at the Burlington Police Department received a report of a disturbance outside Esox, at 194 Main Street. The caller advised that there was a male outside threatening people.

Upon arrival officers made contact with the suspect, Tajon Lytch, 33, who was in a highly agitated state. Mr. Lytch was antagonistic to officers and berated them, but officers assessed no crime was being committed and, when Mr. Lytch appeared to be moving along, the officers returned to their cruisers. As they prepared to return to patrol, an Esox employee approached them and advised that Mr. Lytch had gone back inside and was again causing a disturbance. The business wanted him removed for trespassing.

Officers attempted to assist Esox staff with trespassing Mr. Lytch, at which point Mr. Lytch became disorderly. Mr. Lytch was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct.

During a search incident to arrest, Mr. Lytch was found to be in possession of a stolen 9mm Glock firearm, 3.9 grams of presumptive crack cocaine, 28 grams of marijuana, and more than \$3,000 in cash.

Mr. Lytch was charged with Weapons Possession during the Commission of a Felony, Cocaine Possession (Felony), Persons Prohibited from Possessing Firearms, Possession of Stolen Property, Resisting Arrest, and Disorderly Conduct. He was lodged at the Northwest State Correctional Facility on \$10,000 bail.
