The male was taken into custody and transported to the University of Vermont Medical Center for evaluation.

## NARRATIVE:

On March 22, 2023 at approximately 1606 hours, Officers responded to a male, age 37 with a cutting weapon in the 300 block of Lake Street. The male was threatening self-harm with a knife, actively cutting his neck and bleeding. It was later determined the weapon was a folding knife.

Officers on scene attempted to negotiate with the male. The male continued to pace back and forth, while cutting himself. During this time, citizens at the Skate Park were evacuated. Officers continued to deescalate the situation. The male eventually fled, went over a fence, and entered the railroad track. The Burlington Police Department communicated with the railroad to address possible train traffic.

During the negotiations and deescalation efforts, the male eventually moved towards officers in a manner that occasioned the use of Less Lethal Impact Munitions (LLIMs), specifically a beanbag shotgun. LLIMs sound like, but are not, firearms. No firearms were discharged. The male was struck by the munitions, which facilitated officers taking him into custody. He was transported to the University of Vermont Medical Center for evaluation and treatment for the apparent mental-health crisis.
