NARRATIVE:

On April 14, 2023 at approximately 0814 hours, the Burlington Police Department received a report of domestic assault. The suspect was identified as George Mnyonge, 32, of Burlington.

When officers arrived, they spoke with both victims. Each victim identified Mnyonge and provided an account of the incident. The Burlington Fire Department arrived, attended to the victims, and cleared the scene. Officers located Mnyonge outside, took him into custody, and transported him to BPD. While in his cell, Mnyonge became violent and yelled obscenities at the officers. Mnyonge climbed up the walls of his cell, slipped, and fell. BFD was dispatched to medically evaluate and transported Mnyonge to the University of Vermont Medical Center. Once Mnyonge was cleared from UVMMC, he was transported and lodged on a \$200 bail.

Myonge's criminal records show the following charges and convictions: 20 misdemeanor crimes with five convictions; seven assaultive crimes with two convictions; five violations of court order with no convictions; three felony crimes with no convictions; one sex crime with no convictions.
