The Burlington Police Department would like to follow up with the community and strongly encourage Hyundai and Kia vehicle owners to have their vehicles serviced. We continue to see targeted thefts of Hyundai and Kia vehicles, often times resulting in property damage. As mentioned in our previous public service announcement, an anti-theft campaign has been launched and eligible owners can receive a free software upgrade.

Please continue to lock and secure your vehicles accordingly and review our previous public service announcement provided below for additional details.

The Burlington Police Department would like to notify the community of targeted thefts of Hyundai and Kia vehicles. Due to a software malfunction, certain years and models of these vehicles are vulnerable to theft without a key. We have started seeing an increase in Hyundai and Kia vehicles being stolen, with suspects escalating to smashing windows and forcing their way into these vehicles.
