### NARRATIVE:

On 1/25/2014 a resident of a Lafayette Place apartment returned home to find a female suspect leaving a neighboring apartment with that resident's property. When confronted by the resident, the suspect fled the area on foot leaving behind some of the property she intended on stealing. The on scene investigation showed that the resident witness' apartment had been burglarized along with the neighboring apartment.

A number of days later, the witness recognized the female suspect while at a local establishment and summoned the Burlington Police. Burlington Police Officer Eric Kratochvil pursued many investigative leads which lead to the identification of the female suspect as Jennifer Fuller, 43 years of age, of Burlington, Vermont.

On 2/10/2014 Burlington Police arrested Jennifer Fuller for burglarizing the two apartments on Lafayette Place. Fuller was subsequently lodged for lack of \$5,000 bail and will be arraigned in Chittenden Superior Court – Criminal Division on 02/11/2014.

Burglary is a felony in the State of Vermont and is punishable by a term of imprisonment not to exceed 15 years or a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both
