**NARRATIVE:**

During the month of February 2014, the Burlington Police Department conducted a drug investigation involving a subject identified as Cecil Campbell 33 of Chittenden County, Vermont. On February 11, 2014, an arrest warrant was issued for Campbell due to failing to appear in court on an aggravated domestic assault charge.

On February 12, 2014 Burlington Police Department detectives located Campbell in Winooski, Vermont and took him into custody without incident. During that arrest Campbell attempted to identify himself using another subject's photo ID.

**Cecil Campbell** Campbell is being charged with 2 counts of Sale of Cocaine and False Reports to Law Enforcement. The possible punishments and fines for the above charges are listed below:

**Sale of Cocaine-** A person knowingly and unlawfully dispensing cocaine shall be

imprisoned not more than three years or fined not more than \$75,000.00, or both. A person knowingly and unlawfully selling cocaine shall be imprisoned not more than five years or fined not more than \$100,000.00, or both.

**False Reports**-A person who knowingly gives false information to any law enforcement officer with purpose to implicate another or to deflect an investigation from the person or another person shall be imprisoned for not more than one year or fined not more than \$1,000.00, or both.

Campbell was lodged at Chittenden Regional Correctional Facility on \$25,000.00 bail for the warrant.
