NARRATIVE:

During the months of January /February, 2014, the Burlington Police Department conducted a drug investigation involving a subject who was selling heroin and crack cocaine in the Burlington area. That subject was identified as Matthew Kaigle 26 of Burlington, VT.

On February 13, 2014, Kaigle was arrested without incident by members of the Burlington Police Department and a Vermont State Search Warrant was executed at Kaigle's residence.

Matthew Kaigle Kaigle is being charged with 3 counts of Sale of Heroin, 1 counts of Sale of Cocaine. The possible punishments and fines for the above charges are listed below:

Respect ~ Honor ~ Remember

*Officer James P. McGrath, end of watch May 12, 1904; Officer J. Albert Fisher, end of watch December 15, 1947;
Officer Robert W. Provost, end of watch January 13, 1954*

Sale of Heroin- "A person knowingly and unlawfully selling or dispensing heroin in an amount consisting of 200 milligrams or more of one or more preparations, compounds, mixtures, or substances containing heroin shall be imprisoned not more than 10 years or fined not more than \$250,000.00, or both."

Sale of Cocaine- A person knowingly and unlawfully dispensing cocaine shall be imprisoned not more than three years or fined not more than \$75,000.00, or both. A person knowingly and unlawfully selling cocaine shall be imprisoned not more than five years or fined not more than \$100,000.00, or both.

Kaigle was lodged at Chittenden Regional Correctional Facility on \$5,000.00 bail.
