NARRATIVE:

The Burlington Police Department is currently investigating a motor vehicle crash that occurred on February 17, 2014 at approximately 0900 hours. The crash occurred in the intersection of Main Street and South Winooski Avenue involving two vehicles.

Involved in the crash was a 32 year old female operator, a resident of Burlington, a 22 year old female operator, also a resident of Burlington, and a 5 year old female passenger. All three occupants were transported to Fletcher Allen Health Care with non-life threatening injuries.

Both vehicles, a Ford Focus and a Subaru Forester, sustained significant damage and were towed away from the scene. Main Street and South Union Street were closed for approximately 45 minutes while emergency crews tended to the occupants of the vehicles.

Both Streets are now reopened and the crash is currently under investigation.
