
NARRATIVE:

On December 2, 2013 at 11:00 pm, Burlington Police responded to a report of a taxi being robbed in the area of Archibald Street and Hyde Street in Burlington. The female suspect implied she had a weapon, demanded money, and then fled on foot with less than \$100 in cash; the taxi driver was uninjured. The following months-long investigation resulted in the identification and arrest today of Amber Tahair of Burlington for the offense of Assault and Robbery in this case. Tahair was arrested at the Chittenden County Courthouse on Cherry Street in Burlington where she was appearing for an unrelated multi-count Fraud case that has yet to be resolved.

Tahair was taken into custody and brought for arraignment on one count of Assault and Robbery, a crime punishable by imprisonment for up to ten years. At this time, Tahair is at the Courthouse and her disposition is pending. Tahair's photograph is attached for reference.
