NARRATIVE:

On February 6, 2014 at 9:49 p.m., Burlington Police Officers were dispatched to the Price Chopper parking lot located at 595 Shelburne Road, Burlington, Vermont for a domestic disturbance.

Prior to the officers arriving, the male and female involved in the domestic disturbance left the scene in a silver Pontiac Grand Am. Officers observed the vehicle as it left the Price Chopper parking lot and the Pontiac was stopped on Shelburne Road near the Home Avenue intersection.

Upon investigation, there was no evidence obtained to show the domestic disturbance had become physical. The Pontiac's operator, Sean Kalman, was found to be intoxicated and processed for Driving Under the influence of Alcohol. Kalman was transported back to the Burlington Police Department where he refused to submit an evidentiary breath sample. Kalman was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol (refusal) with a court date of February 25, 2014 at 8:30 a.m.

The passenger in the Pontiac identified as Maureen Seneschal was also charged in the incident for Disorderly Conduct and Resisting Arrest with a court date of February 11, 2014 at 10:30 a.m.
