The following questions were received via telephone and/or email:

1. Who could I talk to about what exists and what is needed for sprinklers?

2. On the sketch labelled UTILITY PLAN power pedestals are shown along the east boundary. On the plan of lighting and power the power on the east side is labelled FUTURE. What is required?

**The utility concept plan (attached & dated 20131216) is the direction we will be moving towards, which shows power bollards along the eastern boundary. This is a conceptual representation of what we are looking for in terms of bollard location and quantity that will be fleshed out during the upcoming design process included in this scope.**

3. On the lighting plan there is reference to Street Lights at the traffic circle. Are these new and outside the scope of this project?

**These three lights are existing and within the College Street ROW. They are not in the scope of work of this project.**

4. Should we include the cost of BPRW light poles, arms & fixtures in our proposals?

**No, please exclude the cost of light poles, arms & fixtures. BPRW will be procuring these materials and supplying them to contractor. Please do include costs for labor and materials to install these components. Remember to include cost of obtaining an electrical (and plumbing) trade permit for this project**

5. Can bidders meet with BPRW staff to review scope?




**It should be noted that all questions for this scope of work were due on February 16, 2015 and that this second addendum was issued to interested parties after the deadline as a courtesy.**
