Dear Hugo & Matt,

On behalf of the City of Burlington Parks, Recreation & Waterfront (“BPRW”), VHB has prepared this Draft Corrective Action Plan (“CAP”) for construction of Phase 1b of the Burlington Bike Path Project (“the Project”). The purpose of the Project is to rehabilitate and reconstruct the Burlington bike path and associated features. The Project will be constructed through a portion of the Alden Waterfront (VT DEC hazardous site #2015-4595), a portion of the Urban Reserve (VT DEC hazardous site #941585) and areas located between the Urban Reserve and North Beach in Burlington, Vermont.

The purpose of the CAP is to specify the procedures that the BPRW’s contractors or subcontractors shall follow during the potential handling of contaminated media within the Project area and to ensure that identified contaminants within the Project area do not present a risk to sensitive receptors during construction activities or during future use. The CAP is not intended to address cleanup activities throughout the entirety of the Alden Waterfront or the Urban Reserve hazardous waste sites beyond the scope of the Phase 1b Project, but is intended to specify construction and contaminant management procedures within portions of the Phase 1b Project area that will encounter these hazardous waste sites and contaminated media.

BPRW and VHB would like to thank the Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation managers in advance for the expedited review time of this CAP, which will commence on March 28th and conclude on April 11th.
